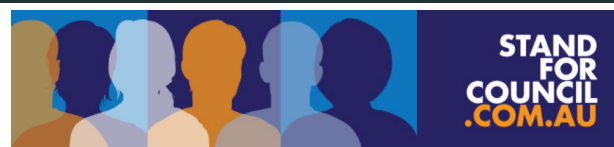

**Community clubs, groups and organisations are encouraged to apply for funding through Warrnambool City Council's Community Development Fund (CDF).**

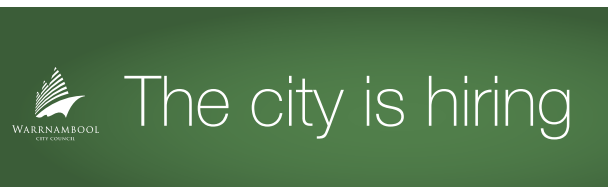
