Warrnambool City Council's Asset Management Strategy 2020

The existing Asset Management Strategy was adopted by Council on 1 December 2014 and is due for review. This strategy has now been revised in accordance with current best practice principles and provides the framework and guiding principles for the processes involved in managing Council assets. It also clearly sets out the actions required to improve the maturity of asset management within Council. With a whole of Council approach to asset management, Council will establish the platform required for the sustainable and responsible management of Council's assets.

The Asset Management Strategy is focused on enhancing asset management governance and capability and has been developed in line with the Asset Management Policy. While it applies to all physical assets, systems, and processes that support the delivery of services to our stakeholders and the community, this document does not contain the service level discussions of each asset class which is found in individual Asset Management Plans.
