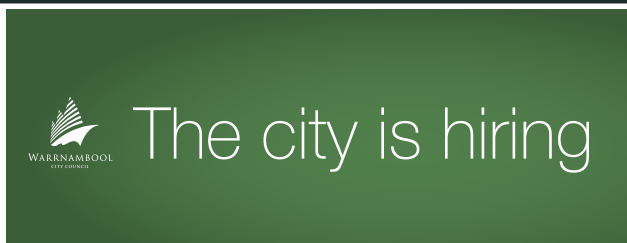
How Safe Do You Feel Along the Foreshore?

In November 2018, Council installed CCTV cameras at Viaduct Road, the Pavilion/Breakwater car park and Pertobe Road (carnival site).

Council received a grant from the Victorian Government's Department of Justice and Community Safety to install these cameras, which are monitored at the Warrnambool police station.
