Changes To Free Parking

Free parking in Warrnambool is changing from 20 July. **From this date, you can park for free in the two-hour spaces in Ozone, Parkers and Cramond & Dickson off-street carparks until 11am each weekday.** These carparks contain a mix of timed and all-day parking spaces and it's important to note that free parking until 11am only applies to the signed 2P spaces.

Regular parking arrangements will resume in all other areas from 20 July. You can pay for parking either by using a parking meter or via the free CellOPark smartphone app.

And as has been the case for a number of months now, everyone is encouraged to take responsibility for their own hand hygiene and physical distancing when out and about.

Warrnambool Planning Scheme Notice of Approval of Amendment Amendment C103warr

The Minister for Planning has approved Amendment C103warr to the Warrnambool Planning Scheme. The Amendment came into operation on 9 July 2020, as published in the Victoria Government Gazette.

The Amendment implements the Warrnambool Eastern Activity Centre Structure Plan 2016 by amending policies within the Municipal Strategic Statement, introducing a new Design and Development Overlay Schedule 18, deleting part of Development Plan Overlay Schedule 1 and introducing Development Plan Overlay Schedule 14.
