In accordance with the principles of the new Act, Council is now seeking community feedback on draft Governance Rules and has provided some accompanying notes on the Governance Rules prior to them being considered at a Special Council Meeting on 24 August 2020. The Governance Rules which replace much of the Meeting Procedure Local Law is required to be adopted by Council by 1 September 2020.
