Warrnambool Fox Baiting Program

The Warrnambool fox baiting program will be undertaken on Council managed land west of the Warrnambool Sewage Treatment Plant to assist in protecting native wildlife, including threatened species, from foxes.

Foxecute, PAPP (para-aminopropiophenone) poison baits will be laid from Thursday 11 June – Friday 10 July 2020.

Baits will be buried to reduce the risk of non-target poisoning. Warning signs will be displayed to notify the public of the program.

The baited area will be closed to dogs and other pets (including dogs on leads), during and up to four weeks after the fox baiting program. Immediate vet assessment is required for any pet suspected of PAPP poisoning. The Vet Group at 59 Mortlake Road Warrnambool holds an antidote.

PAPP poison can be lethal to dogs and cats. Dogs, cats and other pets must not enter the baited Council managed land west of the Warrnambool Sewage Treatment Plant during the following dates: Thursday 11 June – Friday 7 August 2020.
