## Public Notices

### Warrnambool Fox Baiting Program

The fox baiting program will be undertaken on Council managed land to assist in protecting native wildlife, including threatened species from foxes. Baits will be buried to reduce the risk of non-target poisoning. Warning signs will be displayed to notify the public of the program. The baited area will be closed to dogs and other pets (including dogs on leads), during and up to 4 weeks after the fox baiting program.

**Foxecute, PAPP (para-aminopropiophenone) poison can be lethal to dogs and cats. Dogs, cats and other pets must not enter the baited Council managed land west of the Warrnambool Sewage Treatment Plant, areas of Lake Pertobe, Pickering Point and behind the Skate Park between FRIDAY 30 APRIL – WEDNESDAY 23 JUNE.**

Immediate vet assessment is required for any pet suspected of

PAPP poisoning. The following vets are stockists of the antidote:
