- Bringing 'Public Question Time' to the beginning of the Council Meeting.
- Accepting petitions in an electronic form.
- Making livestreaming of Council Meetings a permanent fixture.
- Including 'General Business' in Council Meetings.
- Including an option for the Council to hear submissions at a specialised meeting.

In accordance with section 74 of the Local Government Act 1989, Council must review and determine the level of Councillor and Mayor allowance within the period of 6 months after the general election of by the next 30 June, whichever is later.

Council gives public notice and invite submissions concerning its intention to retain the Mayoral and Councillor allowances at the maximum amount for a Category 2 Council, being \$81,204 Mayoral Allowance and \$26,245 Councillor Allowance.
