Warrnambool Planning Scheme Amendment C99 and Planning Permit Application PP2015-0150

Amendment C99 to the Warrnambool Planning Scheme, combined with Planning Application PP2015-0150, is currently on public exhibition.

Amendment C99 proposes to rezone land at 53-63 Raglan Parade, Warrnambool, 65 Raglan Parade Warrnambool, and 69 Raglan Parade, Warrnambool, to the Commercial 2 Zone. Planning Application PP2015-0150 is for a permit for the use and development of land at 53-63 Raglan Parade, Warrnambool, for motor vehicle sales, motor vehicle servicing and repairs, display of business identification signage, access to a Road Zone 1, and variations to the requirements of Clause 52.14 of the Warrnambool Planning Scheme.
