The naming of Jubilee Park in Woodford is sought to formally acknowledge and recognise the Gunditj Mirring Aboriginal Corporation, Kuuyang Maar Aboriginal Corporation and Eastern Maar Aboriginal Corporation; traditional owners of the area through use of the Aboriginal Placename for the site. This request is consistent with the priorities of the group and the wider Woodford community to formally recognise the traditional owners and the group have worked closely with the Victorian Aboriginal Corporation for Languages who provided the local Aboriginal name.

The office of Geographic Names requires the community to be consulted prior to any naming of public places.
