### **CCS - Child Care Subsidy**

Available to eligible families to assist in reducing the cost of child care.

**Please note:** CCS will not be paid for any booked days when your child hasn't yet physically attended the service for the first time. CCS will not be paid for any days after your child's last physical attendance.

### **Program Operations**

Program operates 8.00am - 6.00pm

Activities take place within the grounds of Warrnambool Stadium, and in the community during excursions.

## **Policy and Procedures**

## **Cancellation Policy**

In event of cancellation of a Vacation Care booking, credit for the cancelled days is only available if the position/s can be filled from the waiting list, for a period of two weeks from the cancellation date. Credit for absence due to illness is only available on presentation of a medical certificate.

#### **General Information**

- All children must be accompanied to the service and signed in and out everyday.
- Medication (including Asthma relievers)
  must be given to the Educators on arrival and
  a authorisation form completed.

- No medication is to be left in your child's bag under any circumstances.
- Please remember to pack a sun hat and water bottle each day.
- **Lunch orders** are available most days unless otherwise specified.
- On excursion days children must be at the Stadium by 9:30am unless advised otherwise.

#### Children's Behaviour

Behaviour that is aggressive, rude, disrespectful, unsafe or socially inappropriate will not be tolerated at Vacation Care, as it is detrimental to the experience of others in the program.

If a child behaves inappropriately the matter will be documented and discussed with the parent/guardian. The child care booking may be reviewed and, at the discretion of the Educator Team and Management, cancelled if necessary.
