The Home and Community **Care Program for Younger** People (HACC PYP) is a program funded by the **Victorian Government to** help people who are needing **Practical & Social Support.**



Practical Support includes:

- Housework
- Shoppina
- **Personal Care including** showering & dressing
- Caring for a partner, relative or close friend
- **Delivered meals**

To access HACC PYP programs, visit your doctor, health worker or service provider and ask them to make a referral that identifies a physical or mental health condition.



Social Support Includes:

- **Community Outings**
- **Social Meetups**
- **Social Clubs**
- **Group Activities**
- **Peer Support**
- **Friendship Networks**
- Care Check-In Calls



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Once the referral is received. the HACC Intake Team will contact you to confirm your eligibility and to discuss the support that you require.
