Support for people under the age of 65 or Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people under the age of 50

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The Home and Community Care Program for Younger People (HACC PYP) is a program funded by the Victorian Government to help people who are needing Practical & Social Support.

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Practical Support includes:

- Housework
- Shopping
- Personal Care including showering & dressing
- Caring for a partner, relative or close friend
- Delivered meals

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To access HACC PYP programs, visit your doctor, health worker or service provider and ask them to make a referral that identifies a physical or mental health condition.

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Social Support Includes:

- Community Outings
- Social Meetups
- Social Clubs
- Group Activities
- Peer Support
- Friendship Networks
- Care Check-In Calls

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Once the referral is received, the HACC Intake Team will contact you to confirm your eligibility and to discuss the support that you require.
