FOGO is a new way to get rid of food and garden waste in Warrnambool City Council.

Your new FOGO bin

You will get a new FOGO bin set.



The new bin will

- be big
- have a green lid.

You will get a new **caddy**.

A caddy is a small bin to keep in your kitchen.

We will also give you green liner bags for the caddy.



We will give you more green liner bags when you tell us you have none left.

How to use your caddy

Put a green liner bag in the caddy.



Put left over food and peels in the caddy.

Put the bag into the FOGO bin when it is full.



Put a new green liner bag in the caddy and start again.

Make sure you **only** line your caddy with

- the green liner bags we give you
- newspaper
- paper bags.

Do **not** put plastic bags in the caddy or FOGO bin.

What can go in the FOGO bin?



All food can go in the FOGO bin. This includes

- fruit and vegetables
- cheese



- meat and bones

- tea and coffee.

Garden waste that can go in the FOGO bin includes



- twigs and small branches



- wood chips

- grass and leaves

- dead flowers.

What cannot go in the FOGO bin?

There are some things you **cannot** put in your FOGO bin.



Things you **cannot** put in your FOGO bin include

- plastic
- nappies



- rocks



- glass
- metal.
