Project update

Following the November 4 engagement session, Brand Architects have been busy incorporating stakeholder feedback into the next stage of design.

At the meeting on December 2 Council moved to accept the Project Control Groups recommendation to a single story concept. This closes out Phase 1 (Concept Development) of the project and enables the design team to concentrate their efforts on design solutions for a single concept throughout Phase II (Functional and Technical Brief) and Phase III (Project Delivery Strategy).

These are expected to be completed in the new year and will be presented to users and stakeholders at the next Stakeholder Engagement meeting to be held **Tuesday January 28**. At this meeting input into the functionality and fit-out of the Pavilion will be sought to move into Phase IV (Schematic and Detailed Design).
