## Major milestone reached as design team appointed

Brand Architects has been appointed as the design firm for the \$11 million Reid Oval Redevelopment, following a unanimous decision by Warrnambool City Councillors on Monday night.

The Melbourne-based practice has a long track record of designing innovative yet highly functional buildings, including a number of modern sporting facilities.

Current and previous projects include the Western Oval redevelopment in Geelong, MacPherson Park redevelopment in Melton, the Caroline Springs Stadium and Tennis Facility and Darebin Stadium.

They will deliver all design aspects of the project at Warrnambool's premier sporting facility, including the preparation of construction specifications.

One of the first items on their agenda will be to come to Warrnambool to work with stakeholders on how each aspect of the project might look and function.
