The subsurface drainage has been installed, the sprinkler installation has been marked out and the concrete foundation for the perimeter fencing is being poured.

We're out of the ground! With the foundations now laid, the pre-cast walls of the ground floor are in the process of being erected.



Training Area

The option to fully upgrade the ground, irrigation, fencing and lighting in the training area has been taken up, with work on this section scheduled to be finished in August.
